# Independence day

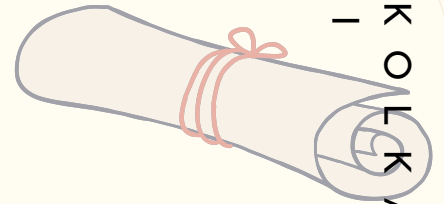

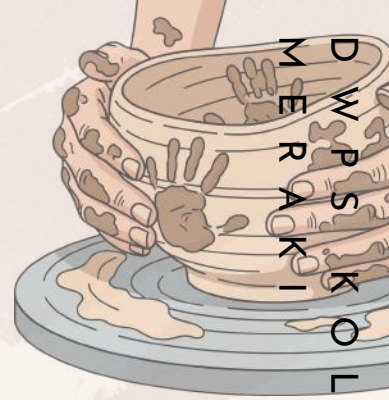

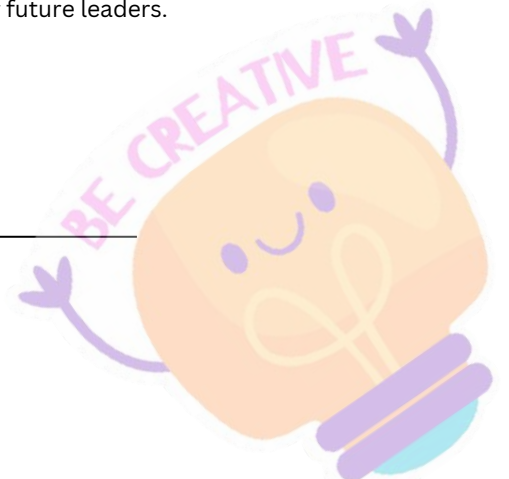


# Voices and Visions: Show & Tell

# Equilibrium: Balancing Mind, Body, and Equality

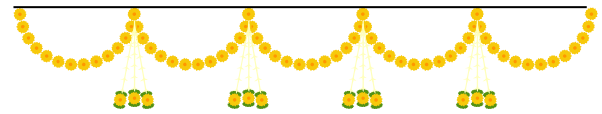
